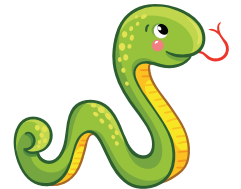


# Names for House Pets in Spanish

# Learning Activity for Names of House Pets in Spanish

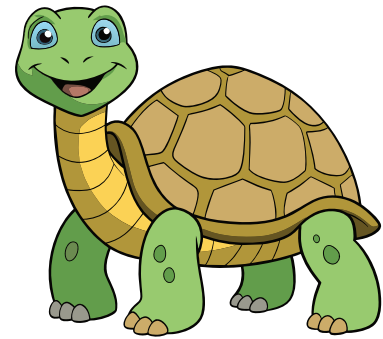
## Names of House Pets Activity

Charades is a fun game that will get your child laughing, acting, and learning. Try playing charades with the Spanish animal names they have worked on.



## What You'll Need

## How to Play Charades with Names of House Pets in Spanish

1. Get some crayons, cut up a piece of paper into strips and write down Spanish animal names of each strip. You'll want two teams, so get the whole family involved!
2. Shuffle the paper strips in a bowl and have a member from each team choose one at random. The Spanish words written on the card will be the animal they have to act out!
3. Give each team member 3 minutes to guess which animal is being acted. For every animal guessed correctly, the team will score a point.
4. Play until the cards run out! This game will be so fun your child won't even realize they are solidifying what they have learned.
